CONTENIDOS:

Eje 1: Technology: Useful gadgets

GRAMÁTICA: Future: Will / Going to. Zero conditional: may, might and could. Phrasal verbs (turn on / take out / put on, etc.)

VOCABULARIO Y LECTURAS: Useful gadgets: electronic devices (digital radio, games console, etc.). A text education: teenagers and their mobiles. Nanotechnology: What's the big idea? Buying clothes: vocabulary. Writing: a formal letter.

Eje 2: Culture and customs: Body language

GRAMÁTICA: Modal verbs: must, mustn't and needn't. First conditional. Phrasal verbs (stand up / turn over / lie down, etc.)

VOCABULARIO Y LECTURAS: An American festival: thanksgiving in the USA. Unusual festivals: the tradition they try to ban. Vocabulary: social activities. Writing: A note.

Eje 3: What if...?: Global issues

GRAMÁTICA: Second conditional. I wish... Word formation: noun suffixes (-ation, -ion, -ness)

VOCABULARIO Y LECTURAS: Going green: Environment quiz. Disaster! Wave power. Vocabulary: volcano, collapse, destroy, etc. Giving advice. Writing: An essay.

Eje 4: Crime Scene: crimes and criminals

GRAMÁTICA: Past perfect. Reported Speech. Word formation: suffixes: -er, -ist and -ian.

VOCABULARIO Y LECTURAS: Sherlock Holmes: Elementary my dear Watson! Computer crime: Sasser. Vocabulary: extreme adjectives. Reporting a theft. Writing: A story

Eje 5: The written word: Publications.

GRAMÁTICA: The passive voice: present simple. The passive voice: other tenses.

VOCABULARIO Y LECTURAS: To be or not to be?: William Shakespeare. A teenage writer: vocabulary: styles of fiction. Buying books: vocabulary: bookshop department. Writing: A book review.

LECTURA: The lost world.
